SNOQUALMIE, WA – Snoqualmie Valley Health, in collaboration with the Snoqualmie Fire Department and the King County Fire Training Consortium, successfully conducted a comprehensive emergency preparedness drill aimed at enhancing the region's readiness to respond effectively to various crisis scenarios.

The joint exercise, held on August 23, showcased the unwavering commitment of Snoqualmie Valley Health to the safety and well-being of the community it serves. Drills such as this simulate a range of emergency situations, including natural disasters and medical emergencies, to evaluate the coordination and response capabilities of all involved parties.
