## 4. 3:20pm -- Discussion and Approval of Decision Matrix

The Decision Matrix aims to create a process that is clear, efficient, honors transparency and engages the board effectively in order to produce a completed project in early 2026. The Commissioners approved the use of the Decision Matrix for the duration of the project.

Kimberly McNally opened the discussion portion of the meeting and offered the floor to Owner Rep, Dick Bratton who explained his role, the developer's role and the reasons for change orders.
