- Electrolyte Imbalance: Correcting imbalances that can signal impaired kidney function.
- Kidney Stones: Providing non-interventional management to reduce future risks.
- Post-Kidney Transplant Care: Offering ongoing nephrology care essential for transplant recipients.
- Acute Kidney Injury (AKI): Delivering immediate attention to prevent permanent damage from sudden kidney function loss.
